Waseda-Oregon Summer Scholarship (www.wasedaoregon.org)

Funding is available for students who have completed all three terms of first or second-year Japanese at PSU and who have been admitted to the Waseda Oregon Summer program. The scholarship will cover entire program fee of \$4,950.

This includes:

- Tuition (12 quarter credits)
- Shared room in residence hall at Waseda University in Tokyo
- Books
- Field trips and other activities
- Access to library, computer and recreational facilities at Waseda University
- Registration fee at Portland State University
- Health Insurance

The scholarship does not include airfare (~\$800), meals (~\$25/day), non-program local transportation expenses within Tokyo(~\$5/day) and personal expenses (~\$10/day).

Application Process: Please submit completed application form, write a 1-2 page reflective essay on why you want to attend this program and how it will contribute to your education. Attach a transcript (unofficial is fine).

Deadline: March 15, 2009

Hokkaido Summer Scholarship

Funding is available for students who have completed all three terms of first or second-year Japanese at PSU, and have been admitted to the Hokkaido Summer program. The scholarship will cover up to \$500 of program fee.

Application Process: Please submit completed application form, write a 1-2 page reflective essay on why you want to attend this program and how it will contribute to your education. Attach a transcript (unofficial is fine).

Deadline: April 15, 2010

Japan Scholarship

Amount: For full-year programs, up to \$5000; for short-term programs, up to \$2500 (amounts will depend on the number of awards)

Criteria of Selection:

- Undergraduate or graduate students fully admitted at PSU;
- Student must be admitted into a PSU-approved education abroad program in Japan;
- overall grade point average of 3.00 or higher;

Application Process: Please submit completed application form, statement of purpose, unofficial transcripts from all colleges and universities attended, statement of financial need, and two letters of recommendation.

Deadline: Applications accepted on a rolling basis
