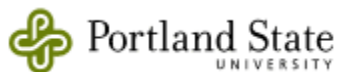

# Scholarship Application - Instructions

## Kawase Scholarship for International Education

*Dr. Takebiko Kawase, Professor of Engineering at Waseda University (Tokyo, Japan) served as Dean of Academic Affairs and Dean of the Center for International Education, and it was in these capacities that he emerged as a true visionary and leader in the area of International Education. His conviction that it is imperative to open the world to the contemporary student motivated him to undertake the leadership in developing the connection between Portland State University and Waseda University. This cooperative relationship is now known as the Oregon/Waseda Program. This scholarship was developed as one way to assist students in their pursuits of studying abroad, particularly in destinations defined as non-traditional.*

**Number of Awards:** Varies from year to year

**Amount:** For programs 10 weeks or longer, awards will range from \$250 - \$1500. For short-term programs, awards will range from \$150 - \$400.

### Criteria of Selection:

- Undergraduate, postbaccalaureate or graduate students fully admitted at PSU;
- Student must be admitted into a PSU-sponsored education abroad program or international internship program;
- Overall grade point average of 3.00 or higher;
- Demonstrate financial need

### Application Process:

Please submit the following application documents:

- Application form
- Statement of purpose (1-2 page essay of why you are pursuing this overseas program & how it will contribute to your future activities)
- Unofficial transcript from PSU (Banner printout OK)
- Statement of financial need (Short essay demonstrating your need for the scholarship versus the costs associated with the overseas program)
- 1 letter of recommendation from a professor or academic advisor

Scholarship awards are made by a committee and funds will be applied against your PSU Banner account during the term you are overseas.
